COMMUNITY SPIRITUAL DIRECTOR – Mary D D'Alessio

"How much longer, daddy? Are we almost there?"

"Mommy, I'm tired of riding. Will we ever get to Grandma's?

Perhaps you remember as a child saying such things on road trips. You wanted to get to "where you were going" and you wanted to be there NOW! Cramped in the back seat of the car, tired of playing silly road games, irritated by your siblings who were trapped with you, your whining cry was, "How long?"

I think that's our cry as the pandemic rages and we're trapped on a journey that seems to have no end. "Will this ever be over? How long? How long, O Lord?"

The cry is not new to us, however. It is one heard throughout scripture, for cries to God for relief arise. "I am sick at heart. How long, O Lord, until you restore me?" [Psalm 6:3]. "How long, Lord? Will you forget me forever? How long will you hide your face from me [Psalm 13:1].

"How long, LORD, will you look on? Rescue me from their ravages, my precious life from these lions" [Psalm 35:17]. "Relent, LORD! How long will it be? Have compassion on your servants" [Psalm 90:13]. "How long, LORD, must I call for help, but you do not listen? Or cry out to you, "Violence!" but you do not save?" [Habakkuk 1:2].

We cry, "Help us, God. We are tired. We are afraid. Our hope wanes. Grief overtakes us. Fear stalks us. We are homesick for the way life used to be." We cry, "How long, Lord?" and God listens. Yes. He listens, but are we listening, too?

For scripture lets us overhear God asking *us*, "How long?".
"The LORD asked Moses, 'How long will these people refuse to obey my commands and instructions?' [Exodus 16:28].

"The LORD said to Moses, 'How long will these people treat me with contempt? How long will

they refuse to believe in me, in spite of all the signs I have performed among them?'" [Numbers 14:11] "How long will you wander, unfaithful Daughter Israel?" [Jeremiah 31:22a].

You see, it works both ways: we ask God, "How long?" and God asks us, "How long?"

Do you see the raw beauty in all of this? There is longing and pain on both sides—ours and God's. We wait on God to rescue us. God waits on us to run to him, believing in him, trusting him.

My Emmaus friends, we are on a journey, and we are making that journey together, joined through our love of Christ. We don't know how long this pandemic will last or if it might have no end at all, but we, like Christ, are to live knowing that we have come from God and will be returning to God, and while we are here, we, like Christ, are to serve one another (see John 13:3-5). Serve one another and love one another, trusting the One who holds our future, trusting the one who is the Way and the Life.
