**Chrysalis Liaison**

(An appointed, one-year commitment that may be held by either an elected, voting member of the Community Board or a non-voting Community member. Option to extend tenure additional year(s) if the individual and the Board approve.)

**Responsibilities:**

1. Be active in an Emmaus Reunion Group or similarly structured weekly accountability group
2. Regularly attend Born Again Emmaus Community Board Meetings and Gatherings
3. Attend Board Training annually (if a Board Member).
4. Protect the intent and integrity of the Emmaus Movement and Model.

**Duties:**

The duty of the Chrysalis Liaison to an Emmaus 4<sup>th</sup> Day community is to promote Chrysalis as an opportunity for the Emmaus community to serve God in various ways. These service opportunities include but are not limited to prayer, sponsorship, financial support, food and general agape, attending Candlelight and Closing Ceremonies and serving on teams.

It is very important for the liaison to communicate upcoming dates for Chrysalis Flights to our Emmaus Community. Chrysalis awareness should be made through the monthly Emmaus Gathering announcements, the monthly Emmaus Newsletter, applications and brochures given out to all Walk to Emmaus Pilgrims, Emmaus email distribution channels and Emmaus Reunion Groups.

Intentionally communicate with area Chrysalis Communities so local boy's and girl's Chrysalis Flights can be announced in a timely manner.
